WE ARE A SUMMER FESTIVAL AND AN ACADEMY

Toronto Summer Music (TSM) is a flagship Festival and Academy that serves to enrich lives within our community through the shared appreciation of music. With a two-fold, interconnected mission, we programme a Festival with prestigious artists, and we operate an Academy that offers high-level training and performance opportunities for emerging musicians as well as adult amateurs. Through these two channels, we actively promote engagement between musicians and their audiences.

20 YEARS OF TSM

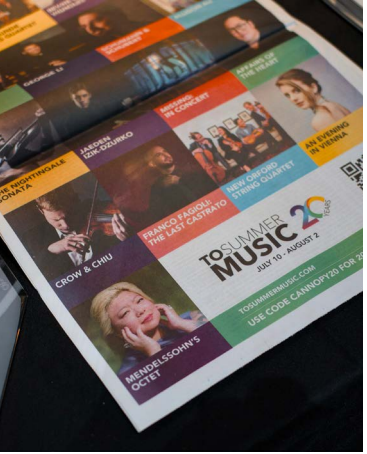
Our 20th Anniversary Festival celebrated both a milestone year for Toronto Summer Music with the culmination of Jonathan Crow's remarkable nine-year tenure as Artistic Director. **We extend our deepest thanks to Jonathan for his inspired leadership, artistic vision, and unwavering commitment to excellence.** Under Jonathan's leadership, the Academy grew to international renown and our stages welcomed celebrated chamber musicians alongside Toronto's own vibrant community of artists. A champion of inclusion and accessibility, Jonathan upheld TSM's mandate: to remove barriers so patrons from all walks of life could experience live classical music. As we celebrated two decades, we also honoured the visionaries who laid the groundwork—Agnes Grossmann, David Beach, and Douglas McNabney—and expressed our heartfelt thanks to the entire TSM community whose steadfast support made this milestone possible. Throughout the Festival, our stages were alive with star-studded performances featuring leaders in their fields, Canadian icons, beloved local musicians, and an exciting cohort of emerging artists from the TSM Academy—together reflecting the excellence, generosity, and shared purpose that define TSM.

AT A GLANCE



ORGANIZATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- TSM was named one of North America's best classical music festivals by *BBC Music Magazine*.
- We welcomed 15,000+ audience members across 58 events, with 13 sold-out events, including: 20th Anniversary Gala, Rosamunde String Quartet, Schmaltz & Pepper, Schumann & Schubert, Affairs of the Heart, Crow & Chiu, New Orford String Quartet, and all six Academy Noon Concerts.
- The TSM Academy drew one of its strongest cohorts to date—28 Fellows from 11 countries (Latvia, U.S.A., South Korea, Canada, China, Switzerland, Brazil, France, Netherlands, U.K., and Spain)—affirming our competitiveness on the world stage.
- Every ReGeneration concert was captured in high-quality, multi-camera recordings with our partners at Riddle Films. Fellows received footage for auditions and career development, while audience members can enjoy highlights on our YouTube channel.
- Celebrating its 10th anniversary, the Community Program welcomed a record-breaking 104 adult amateur musicians and culminated in nine hours of free Community Showcase performances on August 2nd.
- TSM's Board of Directors welcomed Rowley Mossop as Chair, Miriam Myers as Vice Chair, and Sadhisha Ambagahawita as Director.
- We transitioned Sarah Mole from part-time to full-time as Communications & Public Relations Manager, and created a new full-time role—Operations Administrator—welcoming Claire Heinrichs onto the year-round staff.
- We introduced an initiative to provide free tickets to all TSM Festival events to anyone who self-identifies as Indigenous.
- Thanks to the generosity of our Board of Directors, The Whiteside Foundation, Amica Balmoral, and our wider TSM community, our Matching Campaign became the most successful in TSM history, surpassing our goal and raising more than \$175,000.
- With the support of funders, donors, and patrons, TSM closed the fiscal year with a healthy surplus.
- In September, TSM welcomed William Fedkenheuer as Artistic Director.



ARTISTIC HIGHLIGHTS

- TSM artists and Fellows advanced inclusion and the future of classical music in Canada by performing works by 21 living composers, 29 female-identifying composers, 12 BIPOC composers, and 17 Canadian composers, including 6 premieres; across the month-long Festival there were 61 performances of these works.
- Mainstage highlights included Berliner Philharmoniker Concertmaster Noah Bendix-Balgley with the Rosamunde String Quartet; pianist George Li (International Tchaikovsky Competition silver medalist); the Eastern Canadian premiere of the opera *Missing*; countertenor Franco Fagioli with L'Orchestre de l'Opéra Royal de Versailles; and a joyful Vienna-themed celebration featuring mezzo-soprano Simone McIntosh, violinist Yura Lee, pianist Jonathan Mak, and the TSM Festival Orchestra.
- The Free Concert Series, presented by TD Ready Commitment at Heliconian Hall and Walter Hall, returned to enthusiastic, often full houses—frequently reaching capacity for Academy Noon Concerts, Shuffle Series performances, and Masterclasses—and grew attendance by 25% year over year, welcoming 3,770+ people to free TSM programming.
- TSM is part of a thriving community of artistic organizations; in 2025, our artistic partners and collaborators included Riddle Films, ATOM (Artists of the Opera *Missing*), Xenia Concerts, Concerts in Care, University of Toronto Faculty of Music, The Royal Conservatory of Music, Taylor Academy, Heliconian Hall, and the Canadian Association of Violin and Bow Makers.

FREE CONCERT SERIES PRESENTED BY TD READY COMMITMENT:

• KIDS CONCERTS:

TSM's Kids Concerts Series presented three free concerts for children, at Walter Hall and the Edward Johnson Building lobby. 2025 featured Shoestring Opera's whimsical adaptation of Mozart's *The Magic Flute*, Schmaltz & Pepper presenting interactive klezmer and Yiddish music, and VC2 in partnership with Xenia Concerts (family-friendly, accessible musical events that embrace neurodiversity and disability).

• ACADEMY NOON CONCERTS:

Six free noon-hour concerts, each played to a packed house at Heliconian Hall, featuring TSM Academy Fellows.

• SHUFFLE HOUR CONCERTS:

A series of six free, informal, eclectic sampler performances by Festival Artists, special guests, and next-generation performers at Heliconian Hall—your gateway to new musical adventures.

• PUBLIC MASTERCLASSES:

Audiences learn about the tools of the trade in public masterclasses with special guest artists and TSM Academy Fellows as they work on classical works of the repertoire. Featuring mentors Mary Bevan, Estelle Choi, Roger Vignoles, Philip Chiu, and Barry Shiffman.



TORONTO SUMMER MUSIC ACADEMY

The Toronto Summer Music Academy has swiftly become one of North America's pre-eminent summer training programs. The Academy is for chamber musicians, pianists, and vocalists aged 18-35 who are beginning their professional careers in performance.

THE CHAMBER MUSIC INSTITUTE

The Chamber Music Institute for piano and strings welcomed individuals for four weeks of intensive coaching sessions, rehearsals, and performances. They gained valuable performance, mentorship, career, and networking opportunities, helping bridge the gap between post-secondary education and their emerging careers as chamber musicians. With a focus on learning through performance, Fellows rehearsed and performed alongside their Mentors.
